Transportation Connections

Transportation Connections is comprised of several programs to help low-income and/or people with disabilities meet their transportation needs. Programs are offered in Crawford, Juneau, La Crosse, Monroe and Vernon Counties.

Transportation Services helps individuals with various day-to-day transportation expenses.

The Revolving Loan and Repair Program provides 0% vehicle loans and repair services to low-income individuals who are employed.

New Freedom provides mileage assistance to individuals with disabilities and have barriers to transportation.

Transportation Connections also can connect individuals to **Transportation Services** to help with:

- Obtaining a bicycle,
- Earning/reinstatement of driver's license,
- Vehicle registration, and
- Vehicle adaptive devices.

The Revolving Loan and Repair Program

REVOLVING LOAN PROGRAM

If you are employed and lacking a dependable and reliable vehicle, the **Revolving Loan Program** may be for you. The **Revolving Loan Program** may help you purchase an affordable and dependable vehicle. If you are eligible you:

- May qualify for a 0% interest loan up to \$4000,
- Are responsible for the payment of tax, title, and license fees and \$150 administrative fee,
- Must provide proof of full coverage insurance, and
- Will be required to participate in carpooling and/or volunteer driving for six months.

REPAIR PROGRAM

If you are employed, but unable to afford your necessary car repairs, the **Repair Program** may be able to help. If you qualify you will:

- Receive a voucher that covers up to 75% of the repair up to \$500,
- Be required to pay 25% of the repair,
- Be required to participate in carpooling and/or volunteer driving for six months.

New Freedom

If you or someone you know is disabled and their disability impacts their transportation options, **New Freedom** may be the right program. **New Freedom** offers mileage assistance for individuals with disabilities who have barriers to transportation. Those who qualify for **New Freedom** will receive vouchers for mileage which can be used to reimburse:

- Friends and family the federal mileage reimbursement rate; and
- Service providers their rates for transportation.

Mileage assistance can be used for transportation to social, religious, employment, or medical activities. Individuals who provide transportation will be required to fill out a mileage sheet and send it to Workforce Connections, Inc. for payment.

Transportation Connections will assist eligible participants with limited funding on a first come/first serve basis to meet their transportation goals and give them the freedom they deserve.
